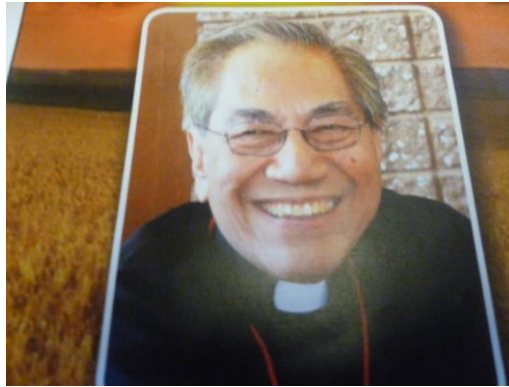

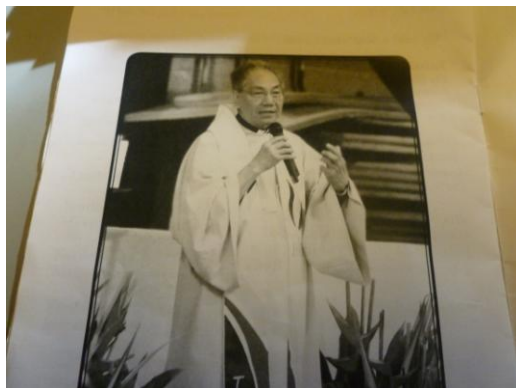


REMEMBERING REV. FR. JOSE ARONG, OMI



Fr. Arong always says that he is a full-blooded Cebuano and jokes that his family is descendants of the mighty Lapulapu.

Enrolled at the University of the Philippines to pursue a dream of becoming a chemical engineers, the dream led to another one- of becoming a missionary and a priest of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate. He was ordained in 1966. After three years of missionary ministry, he was sent to Stanford University for an MA in Anthropology and a PhD in International Development Education.



During his deaconate year, he joined Cursillo #5 in the Archdiocese of Manila, Decuria of St. John. In 1986, he became active in the Cursillo movement and had served pm 3-day weekends at least twice a year and participated in the ongoing formation programs of the Cursillo Movement in the dioceses arund the Bay area: San Francisco, Oakland, San Jose and Sacramento.

- ❖ **Region XI Grand Ultreya – August 8, 2015 (Host - FCC Oakland)** - I sent an email to members of Region XI including Lay Directors from the seven Dioceses. I also copied the deacons and all of our Secretariat members. Sister Neriza and the PCC worked really hard in securing the event place and the Spiritual Speaker. The other logistics such as Witness Speakers, Echo Speakers, and other parts of the program also need to be completed.

- ❖ **Father Jose Arong Memorial Mass – Jan. 16, 2015 @ 7pm** - A memorial mass to celebrate Fr. Jose's 40th day of his passing was organized by several groups from different parishes. This event was held at St. Anne Catholic Church in Union City and it was well attended. Our FCC will be donating \$1,000 for the food expenses (\$700 from surplus funds collected at St. Agnes plus donations from Dcn. Rey \$100 and Bro. Kit Santos \$200, Victoria Edoria \$50).

Last Dec. 14th and Dec. 17th at St. Agnes Church and Sacred Heart Church, respectively, our Oakland FCC came together as one and poured our love and support to say farewell to our beloved Father Jose. Couple of Cursillistas from another diocese mentioned to me during the refreshment get together what they noticed about our FCC unity and expressed their appreciation. Thanks be to God for guiding all of us to be role models in making this possible. Father Jose is now resting in peace and is very proud of all of us.
